

Trinity Academy Uniform Policy

Uniform

We have a gender-neutral uniform policy at Trinity Academy.

The uniform for all pupils is:

- Black skirt, black trousers, black jeans or black skirt and leggings.
- Black or white shirt
- Black Trinity Academy tie (or yellow for sports team members)
- Black shoes or boots
- Optional: black jumper or cardigan
- Optional: Trinity Academy blazer

Hoodies, jackets and jumpers with logos are not part of the uniform, so must be removed in all classes, including registration.

Procedures

Uniform is checked at the door in the morning and pupils not in suitable uniform will be challenged over this.

During registration: any pupil not in full school uniform should be given a blue non-uniform slip by their register teacher. On the third occasion, a pupil should be referred to the appropriate DHT:

Head of Arran - Bryan Campbell

Head of Orkney - Kath Stewart

Head of Skye - James Todd

Pupil will be seen, parents contacted and, where possible, sent home to change. If we cannot contact a parent then a text will be sent automatically and pupils will receive a yellow uniform slip, which they must carry for the remainder of that day. Pupils will also be asked to report to us the following morning to ensure they are wearing uniform.

Latecomers will be checked when signing in and the above procedures will be followed.

During the day, ANY pupil not in uniform and not carrying a blue slip should be sent to relevant Depute Head

With persistent “offenders”, parents will be asked in to discuss the reason for lack of appropriate uniform and support will be offered where necessary.
